### • Director's Report <u>Byron P. Decoteau, Jr., Director</u>

Director Decoteau provided the Commission with background information on the "Ban the Box" initiative, a copy of Act 398 of the 2016 Regular Session, and presented the results and analysis from the SCS Ban the Box Survey.

According to the respondents of the SCS Ban the Box Survey, the attitude toward this initiative for the classified workforce is moderate. No overwhelming support or opposition to removing the conviction history question from the classified employment application was indicated.

The Director informed the Commission of a policy change effective January 1, 2017 for the classified workforce that would do the following:

- Remove questions #16 and #17 from the classified employment application regarding conviction history.
- Empower each agency's appointing authority to make the determination on whether they will ask the question during the application process or not. (If the question will be asked, it will be added as a "supplemental question" at the time of application). The appointing authority will have to state why the question is relevant for the individual position.
- o For all positions that require a conviction history check by law (law enforcement, child welfare, etc.) the supplemental qualification question will be required.

The Commission agreed to the implementation of the Director's policy effective January 1, 2017 for the classified employment application, however, would like to discuss promulgating rules that are inline with Act 398 of the 2016 Regular Session. The Commission would like the Director to bring some rule proposals for the Commission to consider for promulgation at the March 2017 Commission meeting.
