 - Announced the reappointment of Commissioner Carrere to the State Civil Service Commission.
 - Informed the Commission that the Governor has until March 10, 2017 to select his appointment to the Commission for the Third Congressional District.

- o Informed the Commission that the Commissioner for the Division of Administration, Jay Dardenne, recognized that performance adjustments are not funded in the proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year but stated the Administration does not intend to ask this Commission to suspend authority for granting performance adjustments.
- Reminded HR Community that March 15, 2017 is the deadline for agencies to submit items for the April 5, 2017 Civil Service Commission meeting.
- Informed the Commission that results of the State Civil Service Commission Employee Representative election should be announced this week.
