The State Civil Service Commission convened its monthly general business meeting at 9:09 a.m. on Thursday, March 7, 2024. Present were Chairman David Duplantier, Vice Chairman D. Scott Hughes, Commissioners Candes Carter, Craig Netterville, and Jo Ann Nixon. Commissioners John McLure and Codi Neyland were absent.

On motion duly made, seconded, and passed; the Commission took the specified action as listed for each of the requests listed below:

- 1) Consideration of the **Minutes** of the Commission meeting held January 10, 2024. The Commission unanimously approved the minutes as written.

The Commission unanimously ratified the Director's interim approval.

Melinda Robert, Compliance and Audit Administrator, presented the Compliance Audit Quarterly Report to the Commission.

- 25) Request of **State Civil Service** to ratify the Director's authorization of Special Entrance Rates in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.5(b). The Commission unanimously ratified the Director's approval of six Special Entrance Rates between the period of December 23, 2023 through February 22, 2024.
- 26) Report on State Civil Service Rule 6.16(a), Premium Pay policies, up to \$2.00 per hour, approved under the Director's delegated authority. Director Decoteau provided a summary of premium pay policies, up to \$2.00 per hour, approved under the Director's delegated authority.
- Director's Report
 - The <u>SCS Hiring Framework</u>, a suite of competency-based tools for recruiting and hiring, has six steps; however, SCS is requiring agencies to implement the first three steps. SCS highly recommends agencies implement the next three steps, though this is not a requirement. Currently, staff is

working on stage two of the Hiring Framework, which will help agencies effectively sort through data to get the best candidates. Since the elimination of the Professional Level Exam and Office Support Exam, there has been an increase in applicants.

- Later this Spring, the department plans to promulgate transition rules to move the performance management system from a fiscal year to a calendar year.
- SCS staff will start work on implementing OnBoard, a cloud-based board management software system for our Commission.
- The department's executive staff has met with newly appointed Appointing Authorities. The meetings have been an opportunity for the department to hear what the agencies need, as well as to provide information about State Civil Service.
- The <u>2024 Regular Session</u> begins Monday, March 11.
 - Staff is responding to requests for legislative fiscal notes.
 - Staff is monitoring the current legislative bills:
 - House Bills 183 and 563 and Senate Bills 128 and 139: remove Housing Authorities from the State Civil Service system.
 - State minimum wage
 - House Bill 593: provides for a transfer of the employees of the New Orleans sewerage and water board from the city civil service system to the state civil service system.
 - Senate Bill 181: Constitutional amendment to provide for nominations to the Civil Service Commission from public universities.
 - The department appeared before the House Appropriations committee on March 5, 2024. Director Decoteau provided the link of the hearing to the commissioners.
- Consideration of a motion to recess/adjourn for Executive Session to consider Applications for Review of
 Civil Service Appeals and to discuss Personnel Matters. (All Commissioners to verbally vote.) On motion
 duly made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the commission agreed to adjourn for executive session to
 consider review of Civil Service Appeals and Personnel Matters.
