State Civil Service is pleased to announce a new Workforce Planning and Development portal that will be available on April 1, 2015. The portal can be accessed from our website at:

The new portal provides state Human Resources professionals with workforce planning tools in order to forecast talent needs in state government. This page will serve as the official go-to source for workforce planning and development guidance within state agencies. The State Civil Service team developed this model to use as reference to help agencies identify critical workforce issues and to assist them in developing strategies to overcome the problems that these issues create.

This page hosts resources and information for agencies on all aspects of workforce planning, including templates, guidelines, and links. It provides a general information narrative as well as a toolkit that includes resources and key action charts.
