## **GENERAL CIRCULAR NUMBER 2016-010**

TO: Heads of State Agencies and Human Resources Directors

SUBJECT: Final FLSA Rules Announced

This general circular is a follow-up to General Circular 2015-028 regarding FLSA Notice of Proposed Rule Making. On May 18, 2016, the Department of Labor (DOL) released its final regulations making changes to Part 541 governing overtime exemptions under the Fair Labor Standards Act. A summary of the key elements of the new regulation are listed below:

- 1. Salary Threshold will change to \$913/week (\$47,476 per year).
- 2. Automatic Salary Threshold increases every 3 years to maintain level at the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in the lowest wage census region.
- 3. Duties test is unchanged.
- 4. Final Rules become effective December 1, 2016.
- 5. Highly Compensated Employees (HCE) exemption is now \$134,004 per year.
