Annual Performance Planning and Review Report Fiscal Year 2010-2011

(Submitted to the Director of Civil Service and the Civil Service Commission on November 2, 2011)

In accordance with Civil Service Rule 10.12 (c), state agencies are required to submit an annual Performance Planning and Review (PPR) report to the Director of Civil Service. The report for fiscal year 2010-2011 is attached to this memo.

The documents which are included in this report are as follows:

Statewide Summary Report

The statewide summary report provides statistical information for all major departments which reported PPR information to the Department of Civil Service for fiscal year 2010-2011. It details the

- number of classified employees for whom ratings were required
- number of employees actually rated
- number of employees not rated
- number of employees rated below satisfactory; and
- number of employees rated that received a merit increase.

The summary report also includes a graphical depiction of PPR ratings for fiscal year 2010-2011 and the reasons reported for Un-Rated ratings in this past fiscal year.

Major Department Report Summaries

These reports provide the statistical data for the individual agencies by major department. It includes the same categories of information as the Statewide Summary Report.

Un-Rated Rates in Descending Order by Personnel Area

This report sorts the responding agencies broken down by personnel area in descending order according to the percentage of employees who were *not rated* for fiscal year 2010-2011. Agencies appearing at the top of the list have the highest Un-Rated rates, starting at 41.94% Un-Rated for the Gov-Mental Health Advocacy Services. The agencies appearing near the end of the list, with 0.00% Un-Rated, reported that they rated all their employees during this period. When viewing the Un-Rated rates for each agency, please also note the employee count for each agency, which appears in the second column, "Employee Count." As has been discussed in past years, we would be concerned by a high Un-Rated rate at a small agency (e.g. board or commission); even if there were only a handful of classified employees. We are more alarmed however by an Un-Rated rate of 15-30 percent at an agency having a significantly greater number of employees (50 or more). We have concluded that the larger the agency, the greater the impact of a high Un-Rated rate. It is our experience that a lack of strong performance management programs adversely impacts the morale of employees, resulting in decreased productivity, which affects the ability of the agency to achieve and/or maintain its mission. Units of local government are not included in this table but are included in the Major Department Report Summaries.

Agencies Not Reporting in Fiscal Year 2010-2011

Included in this annual report is a list of agencies which did not report. The number of employees for which rating information was not submitted totals 110.

Statewide Un-Rated Rate in FY 10/11

For Fiscal Year 2010-2011, there was a .49 % increase in the statewide percentage of Un-Rated employees, and there were 3,805 fewer state workers this fiscal year to rate than last fiscal year. Agencies reported PPR ratings for 52,032 classified employees in fiscal year 2010-2011, and the overall Un-Rated rate was 2.97%, up from last fiscal year's rate of 2.48%.
