



The following report has been prepared for the State Civil Service Commission. The data presented in this report is based upon an analysis of the number of classified employees serving in non-temporary positions who separated from state service during fiscal year 2013-2014, as reported by the employing agencies to the Department of State Civil Service.

The information in this report does NOT reflect the following.

- Separations of unclassified employees
- Separations of temporary classified employees
- Transfers of employees from one state agency to another

Data presented throughout this report is categorized as Total Turnover and Voluntary Turnover.

- Voluntary Turnover: Separations from state service due to resignation, retirement or death.
- Involuntary Turnover: Separations from state service through dismissal, layoff, separation during probationary period, or non-disciplinary removal.
- **Total Turnover:** Voluntary Turnover + Involuntary Turnover

Turnover rates shown are calculated by comparing the number of non-temporary classified employees in state service on June 30, 2014 to the number of non-temporary classified employees who separated from state service during the previous twelve months.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The statewide turnover rate for FY 2013-2014 was 23.78%. This is a decrease of 8.02% from FY 2012-2013. The statewide voluntary turnover rate for FY 2013-2014 was 14.53%. This is a decrease of 4.36% from FY 2012-2013.

The occupational groups of professional medical, laboratory and diagnostic, and nonprofessional medical saw the largest statewide turnover rates. The medical pay schedule saw the highest turnover rate with 98.46% up from the 85.44% that was reported last year. Five of the top ten job titles with the highest turnover were medical titles: RN 2, Practical/Nurse Licensed 2, Nursing Assistant 2, RN 3, and RN Supervisor A. Three of these titles were not in last year's top ten.

While there was an overall decrease in statewide turnover there still continues to be a decrease in the number of state employees. There was also still a large increase of turnover in the medical field. There were 37,890 employees at the end of FY 2013-2014, down from the 41,644 at the end of FY 2012-2013. This is a decrease of 3,754 employees. Most of this decrease in state employment is attributed to the layoff of 2,349 permanent and probational employees in FY 2013-2014.

The increase in the medical schedule statewide turnover can be attributed to the official closure of four facilities in FY 2013-2014: LSU Health Sciences Shreveport, E.A. Conway, Bogalusa Medical Center and Huey P. Long Medical Center.

The Statewide turnover rate excluding the separations due to layoffs is 17.58%.
