NOTE: The (3) Job Posting Templates will replace the previous *LA Careers Recruitment Lifecycle and Quick Sheets - Insight Posting Notes* document.

Due to the recent implementation of the <u>State Civil Service Hiring Framework</u>, removal of the Professional Level Exam (PLE) and the Office Support Exam (OSE), and the repeal of SCS Rule 22.8(c), SCS recognizes that various updates are needed within the HR Handbook. SCS staff are currently reviewing the contents of the HR Handbook in its entirety and will be releasing additional updates as it relates to these changes.
