The State Civil Service Commission convened its monthly general business meeting at 9:10 a.m. on Wednesday, May 1, 2019. Present were Chairman David Duplantier, Vice-Chairman D. Scott Hughes, Commissioners John McLure, G. Lee Griffin, Ronald Carrere, Jr. and Jo Ann Nixon. Commissioner C. Pete Fremin was absent.

 No requests received from the public to address the commission.

On motion duly made, seconded, and passed; the Commission took the specified action as listed for each of the requests listed below:

- 1) Consideration of the Minutes of the Commission meeting held on April 3, 2019. The Commission approved the minutes as written.
- 2) Resolution to express gratitude and appreciation to all state classified employees for their outstanding service to the citizens of Louisiana. The Commission adopted the Resolution as written.
- 3) <u>Public Hearing to consider proposed changes to the Classification and Pay Plan</u>. (Details contained in General Circular 2019-012). The Commission conducted a public hearing to consider proposed changes to the Classification and Pay Play and provided opportunity for public comments.
 - On motions duly made, seconded, and passed; The Commission approved the pay plan proposals for Exhibits A & B, being contingent upon the Governor's approval and granted authority to the Director to set the effective date to be no sooner than 10 days after the date of gubernatorial approval; approved Exhibits C & D and granted authority to the director to set the effective date to be no sooner than 10 days after the date of gubernatorial approval of Exhibits A & B; and ratified director's approval for Exhibit E with an effective date of February 15, 2019, for the Federal Energy Program Manager.
- 4) Request of the <u>Department of Education to exempt from the classified service six (6) Govern for America Fellows, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 4.1(d)2, effective May 1, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request as recommended, effective May 1, 2019 through March 5, 2023.
- Request of <u>Florida Parishes Human Services Authority to exempt from the classified service (1) Nurse Registered position, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 4.1(d)2, effective May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2023.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.

- Request of the Louisiana Department of Health, Office of Behavioral Health, Central Louisiana State Hospital to extend authority to exempt from the classified service two (2) Liaison Officer positions, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 4.1(d)2, effective April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2023. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.
- 7) Request of Louisiana State University and A&M College to establish a Premium Pay policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.16(a) effective May 1, 2019. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request, retroactive to April 6, 2019.
- 8) Request of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners to amend its Rewards and Recognition policy in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 6.16.1, effective May 1, 2019. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.
- 9) Request of <u>Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center-Shreveport to amend a Special Entrance Rate</u>
 <u>Policy for the Laboratory Tech Assistant job series under the provisions of State Civil Service Rule 6.5(b),</u>
 <u>effective May 1, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.
- 10) Request of <u>Louisiana State University and A&M College to establish a Special Entrance Rate Policy for the Laboratory Tech Assistant job series under the provisions of State Civil Service Rule 6.5(b), effective May 1, 2019.</u> (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.
- 11) Request of the <u>Department of Public Safety and Corrections</u>, <u>Public Safety Services</u>, to pay all non-exempt and exempt Emergency Support Function Workers at the time and one-half rate, in accordance with <u>State Civil Service Rules 21.8(b)</u> and <u>21.9(d)</u>, effective June 1, <u>2019</u>. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request as recommended, effective June 1, <u>2019</u> through May 31, <u>2024</u>.
- 12) Request of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries-Office of Wildlife to extend the job appointment of Casey Wright, Biologist 3, in accordance with State Civil Service Rule 23.5(a), July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. (Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.
- 13) <u>Monthly Contract Review Report</u> Director Decoteau provided a summary of contracts reviewed by the Department for the period of March 26, 2019 through April 21, 2019.

(Representative of the agency to sign in at door upon arrival to answer any questions of the Commission.) The Commission granted the request.</u>
