The State Civil Service Commission convened its monthly general business meeting at 9:16 a.m. on Wednesday, June 5, 2019. Present were Chairman David Duplantier, Vice-Chairman D. Scott Hughes, Commissioners Ronald Carrere, Jr., C. Pete Fremin, G. Lee Griffin, John McLure and Jo Ann Nixon.

On motion duly made, seconded, and passed; the Commission took the specified action as listed for each of the requests listed below:

- 1) Consideration of the Minutes of the Commission meeting held on May 1, 2019. The Commission unanimously approved the minutes as written.
- 2) <u>Public Hearing to consider proposed changes to the Classification and Pay Plan</u> (Details contained in General Circular No. 2019-019). The Commission conducted a public hearing to consider proposed changes to the Classification and Pay Plan and provided opportunity for public comments.
