## GENERAL CIRCULAR NUMBER 2016-046

**DATE:** December 15, 2016

**TO:** Heads of State Agencies and Human Resources Directors

**SUBJECT:** Ban the Box – Fair Chance For Workers With Records

The purpose of this general circular is to advise that State Civil Service will initiate a new policy regarding the use of questions concerning prior felony convictions on the application for employment for classified positions effective January 1, 2017. There has been a growing movement in the United States to ban these questions on employment applications in order to give released former offenders improved chances of being called for job interviews.

This change is in keeping with legislation that was passed during the 2016 legislative session which removed questions related to felony convictions during the application process for unclassified jobs. The State Civil Service Commission will consider promulgating a formal rule change for classified jobs related to Ban the Box issues in the coming months; therefore, this policy will be a precursor to that formal rule process.

Effective January 1, 2017, the following questions will be removed from the agency-wide questions on all application templates used by State Civil Service for classified jobs:

**Q: Have you ever been on probation or sentenced to jail/prison as a result of a felony conviction or guilty plea to a felony charge?**

**Q: If "YES", give the law enforcement authority (city, police, sheriff, FBI, etc.) the offense, place, and disposition of case.**

State Civil Service will allow the addition of supplemental questions related to felony and similar criminal backgrounds to the application for employment for jobs which have a legal

restriction to hiring candidates with such backgrounds as stated on these job specifications under Necessary Special Requirements or a similar note. A list of these applicable jobs is attached for your convenience.

For other jobs, it will be at the sole discretion of the agency to determine whether or not to add supplemental questions concerning convictions.

As part of the normal workflow, the Staffing division will be reviewing postings before activating them to ensure that conviction questions are present for those jobs which have a legal restriction (refer to the attached list).
