State Civil Service Commission announces Adrienne Bordelon as the State Examiner of Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service

The Louisiana State Civil Service Commission announced yesterday that Adrienne T. Bordelon has been selected as the new leader of the Office of the State Examiner, Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service.

“I want to sincerely thank all of the applicants. It was a difficult choice, but the commission ultimately decided that Adrienne would be the best candidate to move the agency’s mission forward,” said David Duplantier, chairman of the State Civil Service Commission, after the Commission announced its decision.

Bordelon previously served as the General Counsel for Louisiana State Civil Service, and has served as Interim State Examiner for the Office of the State Examiner since September 2018. Bordelon has over 19 years’ experience in state government.

The classified examiner position was advertised locally and with statewide human resources organizations.

“I am humbled and honored to be selected as the State Examiner,” said Bordelon. “I am excited to continue to serve the citizens of Louisiana by ensuring that municipal law enforcement agencies and fire protection districts align with the principles of the civil service system.”

Article X of the Louisiana Constitution charges the State Civil Service Commission with selecting the Fire and Police State Examiner. The Fire and Police State Examiner serves as the director of the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service. The State Examiner administers a civil service system for fire and police personnel in cities throughout Louisiana.
